They escape and end up in the home of down-on-his-luck songwriter Dave. After almost destroying Dave's apartment, he tosses them out into the rainy night but has a change of heart when he hears them singing outside his window. He quickly writes them a song, takes it to his ex-schoolmate Ian, now a major music industry executive, and in moments the furry trio is the Next Big Thing. But Ian lures the Chipmunks away from Dave and works them til they drop.

ANT BULLY, THE

As part of the ant colony, Lucas faces dangers from wasps and bullfrogs, learning important lessons about friendship and courage.
