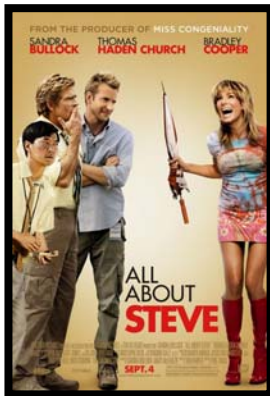
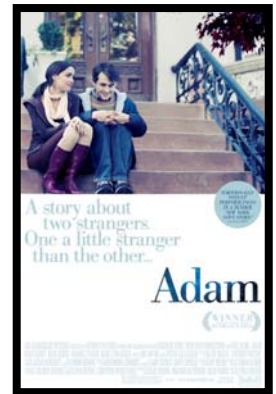

Adam is a handsome but intriguing young man with Asperger's Syndrome, who has all his life led a sheltered existence. After his father dies, he is left alone in their New York apartment. When he meets his new neighbour, Beth, Adam is at first intrigued and then romantically interested - but he doesn't know how to manage his Asperger's. Beth takes to him and tries to help, and introduces him to her parents. But complications erupt when Adam discovers she was not totally honest with him and her accountant father is charged with an indictable offence. **DVD only available May 5.**

When crossword puzzle constructor Mary Horowitz is set up on a blind date with news cameraman Steve, Mary thinks the chemistry is undeniable and just knows she's found her soulmate. She decides to do anything and go anywhere to be with him. Mary's escalating infatuation is encouraged by the self-serving actions of news reporter Hartman Hughes who enjoys torturing his insolent cameraman at every opportunity. As the news team criss-crosses the country covering breaking news stories, Steve becomes increasingly unhinged as Mary trails them. But when the overzealous Mary becomes embroiled in the news story of the year, Steve and Hartman begin to see her differently. **DVD only available May 5.**

AMELIA

After becoming the first woman to fly across the Atlantic, Amelia Earhart is thrust into a new role as America's sweetheart - the legendary 'goddess of light,' known for her bold, larger-than-life charisma. Yet, even with her global fame solidified, her belief in flirting with danger and standing up as her own, outspoken woman never changes. She is admired by all, including First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt to the men closest to her heart: her husband, promoter and publishing magnate George P. Putnam, and her long time friend and lover, pilot Gene Vidal. In the summer of 1937, Amelia sets off on her most daunting mission yet: a solo flight around the world that she and George both anxiously foresee as destined, whatever the outcome, to become one of the most talked-about journeys in history. **DVD only available May 5.**

MY LIFE IN RUINS

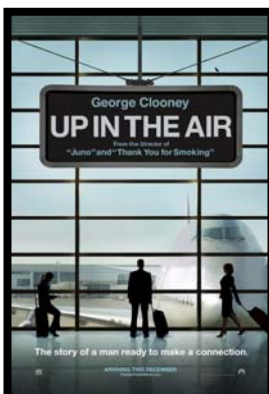
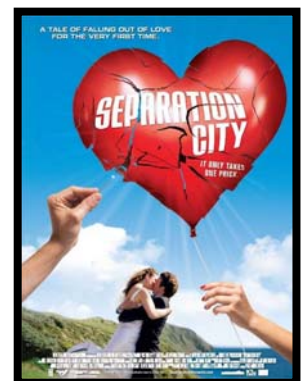
Comedy/Romance, Rated PG, 95 Minutes

Starring: George Clooney, Vera Farmiga, Anna Kendrick

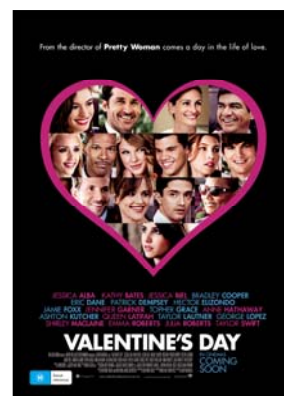
